General

Scouts will be camping under canvas – so plan accordingly. This is a Patrol competition camp based on camping skills. Activity points will be awarded. Scouts will be required to camp in Patrols. Patrols will be required to do some of their own cooking over the weekend. For the rest of the time they will rejoin the Troop for meals.

There are shower and toilet facilities available on-site. Remember that it may be cold. Bring a proper raincoat and torch. Mess kit is essential (of course).
