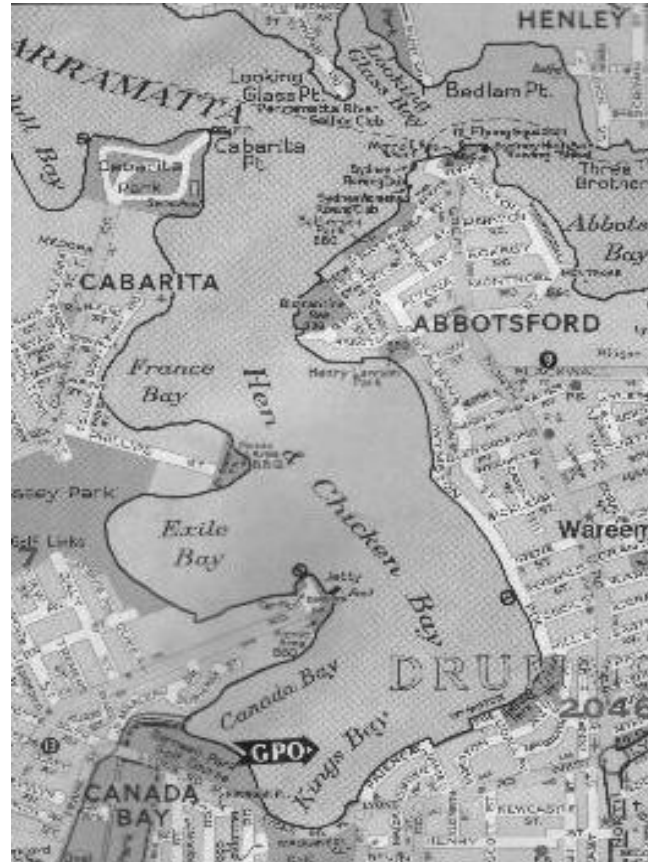

## CLASSES (CREW)

Cubs canoe events only  
Junior Scout or Venturer  
Senior Rover, Leader, other adult  
(boats rated on oldest crew member)

## POINTS (all events)

1<sup>st</sup> 10 points  
2<sup>nd</sup> 5 points  
3<sup>rd</sup> 3 points

Junior points count **double** towards total

## ENTRY FEES

Sailing boats \$5 per race  
Sailboards \$5 per race  
Canoes Free  
Camping \$5 per person

## RULES

*"The Scout Law is the Law of this event".*

### Personal

- Uniform for arrival, parades
- All entrants must be able to swim 50m
- Suitable footwear at all times
- PFD to be worn in boats at all times

### Boats

- Current Certificate/ sticker, or
- Comply with Scout Policy

### Camping

- Lightweight tents- no trenches etc
- No fires- gas cooking only
- Please take All rubbish with you or put in bins please.

## RACING

AYF Rules apply; the Controller's decision is final in all cases.

Catamarans are welcome to race.

The AYF (Victoria) 2006-07 Yardstick system applies:

- each class of boat is allocated a rating (YS) based on records over a wide

range of conditions... the slower the boat the higher the YS.

- actual race times are adjusted by the formula: Corrected Time = Actual Time x 100 :- YS.
- Adult handicap: 15 added to CT

Canoes races are for Canadian canoes only.

## NOTES

Please let our Regatta Office at the Scout hall know numbers when you arrive. Showers are available at the Scout hall, which is a short walk from the campsite and the public toilets on site will be clean.

The gate at the end of Spring St will be open from 8.00pm Fri. for unloading boats and gear only.

**By Council regulation no cars are permitted to be left parked on the Reserve.**

## FIRE

Please bring a fire extinguisher and water bucket to be kept by your tents. Check your gas bottles and fittings before you leave your hall.
